

CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

- **Individual Register fee is \$120, covering the playing cost for the entire season, including injury insurance.** This fee is required before close of registration date as detailed on our website. Upon submission of this registration form, an email and text message will be issued to you with online payment transfer instructions. Individual registering players **WILL NOT** be allocated a team until this fee has been paid.
NOTE: If for some reason we cannot allocate you a team to play in and/or you decide to change your mind after you have paid your registration fee, CPD Oztag Association will refund your payment back via the method you paid. Please be aware that registration fees cannot be refunded once you have participated in a competition game.
- Players are responsible to be aware of CPD Oztag's conditions of play, competition guidelines and insurance policy and procedures available on our website via the 'Registration' tab, under 'EXTRA FORMS DOWNLOAD' http://www.cpdoztag.com.au/registration-information_5672.html . These documents detail our competitions structures, policies, rules and injury insurance information. Players signing this registration form and weekly sign-on sheets whilst participating in a CPD Oztag competition understand they are bound to all conditions and are subject to their penalties.
- Minimum of 10 and a Maximum of 16 registered players required per team
- All team members must wear a top that matches in colour and displays numbers on back and/or sleeves. Teams that fail to do so will be handicapped 1 point for every player out of uniform, that is, their opposition will start the game with a "points" head-start. This is at convenor's discretion.
- Only people registered on the Team Registration form are permitted to play for that team throughout season. Any teams caught playing unregistered players will be stripped of their competition points for that game. If the team is found to repeat the offence all comp points will be taken and risk being ejected from the competition
- All players must sign the 'team sign-on sheet' weekly before taking the field to play their game. This is for insurance and qualifying finals rounds purposes (refer to EXTRA FORMS DOWNLOAD for further details).
- Players must have played 5 regular season games to qualify to play semi-finals and finals rounds. This will be tracked through the seasons 'weekly sign-on sheet' records. Players who have not recorded a total of 5 signed-on games will not be permitted to play semi-finals and finals rounds. This condition is non-negotiable.
- All players must wear Oztag brand shorts (purchased at venue). Players who do not have Oztag brand shorts will not be permitted to play.
- Any player who is sent-off will receive a minimum 1 game suspension for the following round and may be extended beyond this depending on the severity of their offence (refer to 'Competition Guidelines'). This will be at the competition convenor's discretion.
- Any player who throws a punch will immediately be suspended from the remainder of the competition with no refund on registration fees. AOSA and CPD Oztag endorse a NO PUNCH POLICY and zero tolerance for unsportsman-like, aggressive behaviour.
- Team delegates are required to contact competition convenor prior to 3pm of competition day if they are aware their team is going to forfeit their game for that round. If this is done, they will still receive 1 competition point for a loss (as per usual). Teams that fail to abide by this condition (providing no notice of their forfeit) will receive no comp points as well as minus 5 points for their 'for and against' tally on their first offence. If this re-occurs the entire team will be suspended for the following round and risk being ejected from the competition with no refund on fees.

In players signing the Individual Registration Form and weekly sign-on sheets throughout season, all understand and agree to abide with AOSA and CPD Oztag Associations policies stated in these '[Conditions of Registration, Competition Guidelines and Conditions of Play](#)' documents (located on the website on 'Registration' tab – under 'Extra Forms Download'). All players are required to be aware of such policies, terms and conditions AOSA and CPD Oztag Association enforce upon its players in order to maintain a professional organisation as well as protect player's interests and well-being.

Please fill out the Individual Registration form below accordingly and click the send button to submit the form when completed. The competition convenor will respond in email when received and supply directions and information of how and when you can finalise registration fees to complete registration process. Once the competition convenor has allocated you into a team you will be notified. This will be organised no later than the weekend before Round 1 of competition and all details will be forwarded to you ASAP.
